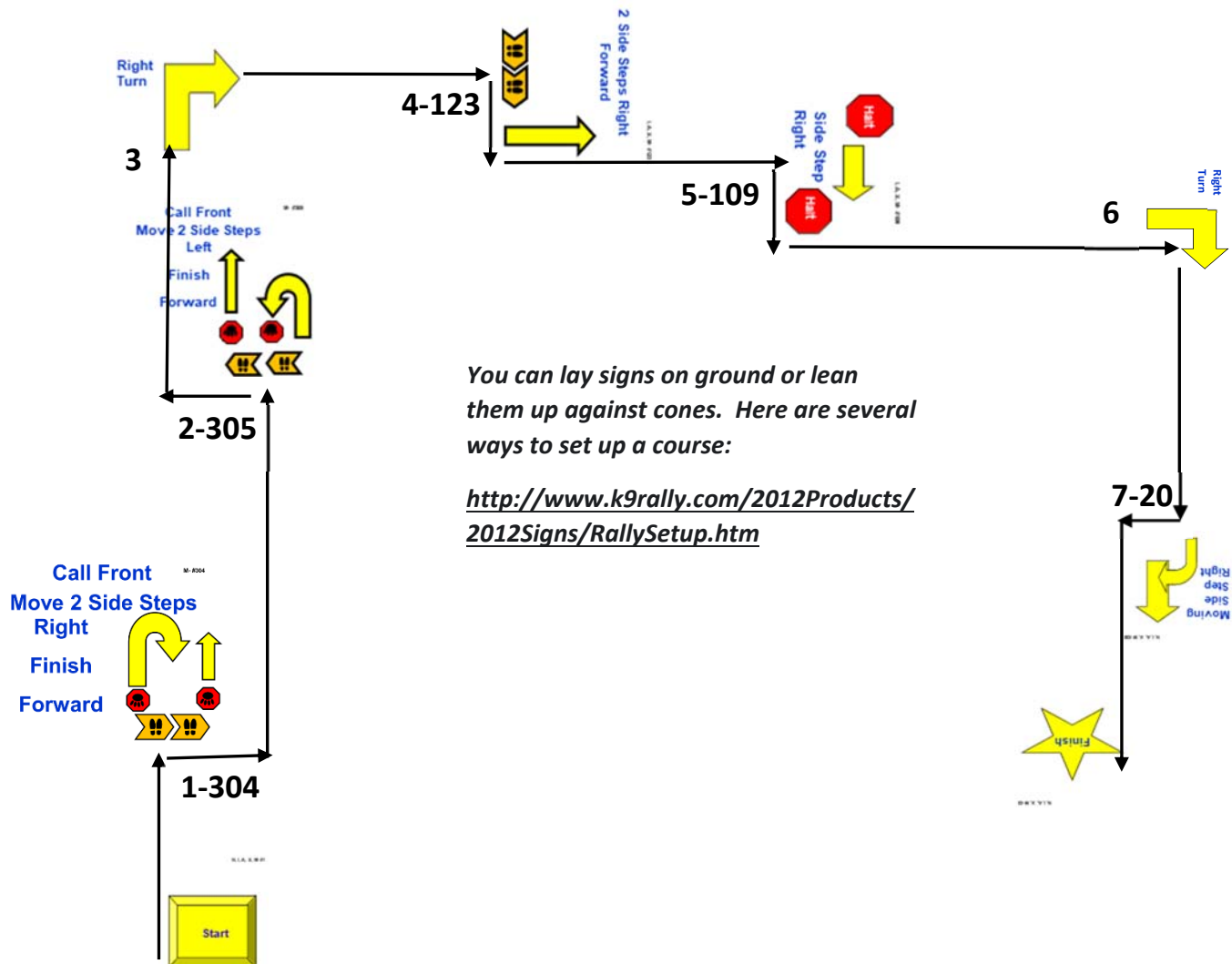
If you'd like to have some challenging Advanced Rally course practice, I'd like to offer this to you.

The hardest thing about Rally, as you probably know by now, is for you, the handler, to perform the required skill and to also know how to get your dog to do their part. If you make a mistake, so does your dog. Most of the deductions in

Rally are caused by the Handler!!! 😱

Are you ready to try your first challenge using AKC Rally signs that use side steps? The signs I'll be using are #s 304-305-123-109-and 20

I – These are ALL Changes of Direction (COD) which means your course path goes directly towards each of them! Your movement to the right or left will get you onto the new course path.



There are 111 signs in Rally. important skill you dog needs to do is to stay on your left side and walk with you. That's called "heel position".
